

Scholarship Information

Scholarships are given to families with limited budgets who cannot afford to pay full camp fees. We understand the importance of a quality summer environment for your child, and we have set up specific guidelines to accommodate those families in need of financial aid.

To obtain a scholarship, complete the online form. Once we receive your form, you will be considered for a scholarship. Our Financial Committee weighs each application on the basis of availability, need and other considerations to determine eligibility. You will receive a response from the Committee within 60 days of the receipt of your camp scholarship application, as to whether you were accepted or denied, and for what amount.

The scholarship committee bases its' decisions on a variety of considerations:

- a. Date application was submitted and payments received.
- b. Grade your child may be in.
- c. There may be a difference between a boy and a girl.

There are many other considerations, most of which may not apply when considering a Shliach, but may still have an impact on their decision, such as:

- a. Salary
- b. Size of family
- c. Years children attending camp

If you are approved for level you have chosen in your Payment Plan, you will be able to continue with the registration process. If you are not accepted to the level you request, you will be notified which level you are accepted at. At that point you will have 15 days to submit your acceptance of the remaining funds at that level. Unless we receive those additional funds and your written acceptance, your place will become open for someone else.

Please note: If there are no scholarship funds, we cannot guarantee your child a place in camp, even at full price. Also, please understand that scholarships are given in the order that they are received.
